Table 33: Foreign-born population by country of birth for the United States and divisions, 1870-1910, and for states, 1890-1910. The table is organized into columns for 'Persons Born In-' categories: Northwestern Europe, Southern and Eastern Europe, Southern and Eastern Europe-Continued, Asia, and America (outside of the United States). It includes sub-sections for the United States, Geographic Divisions, and various states.

1 Prior to 1900 persons reported as born in Poland are included under "Other Europe"; for the censuses of 1910 and 1900 (so far as possible) they are distributed under Austria, Germany, and Russia, respectively.
2 Includes Finland prior to 1900. See also Note 1.
3 Included with Russia prior to 1900.

4 Turkey in Asia included with Turkey in Europe prior to 1910.
5 Includes "Europe, not specified"; also for 1900 "Poland, not specified," and for 1890, 1880, and 1870, all Poland.
6 Newfoundland included with Canada prior to 1910. Canada-French not separately distinguished in 1880 and 1870.
